



SAVAGE CITY PARK POLICIES

The Savage Parks and Recreation Department wants to ensure every visitor and renter to the parks has a positive experience. In order to ensure the parks and the picnic shelters are properly maintained, we ask that you abide by the following policies.

- Park hours are from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. Usage of the parks after 10 p.m. requires a special permit.
- Pets must be leashed at all times. Pet owners are responsible for pickup and removal of animal waste in an appropriate manner.
- Tobacco use is strictly prohibited unless in designated areas.
- Absolutely no vehicles, including food trucks, allowed on the sidewalks or trails.
- Fires are only allowed in designated areas.
- Please place all garbage in receptacles provided.
- Use of firearms, archery, hunting or trapping is strictly prohibited. Archery is permitted at the Hidden Valley Archery Range.
- Snowmobiles and ATV's are not permitted in City Parks, unless on a designated trail.
- Motorcycles allowed on roadways and parking areas only.
- Glass beverage containers are not allowed in park.
- It is unlawful to bring beer into a park in kegs, barrels or other bulk tap quantities. No consumption on or within thirty feet of a roadway or parking lot within a park or on any athletic field.

Picnic Shelter reservations must include full payment at the time of reservation. There are no refunds for shelter reservations that are cancelled by the renter or due to inclement weather.

Cancellation by the City: The City of Savage reserves the right to cancel this rental agreement prior to Date of Use, or at any time when a state of emergency is declared by the City of Savage, if utility services are interrupted or unsafe environmental conditions exist in the opinion of the City of Savage. In such an event, Renter agrees that the City shall have no responsibility or liability for any disruption, damages, or loss that the Renter may suffer or incur due to such cancellation. The City will attempt to notify Renter as soon as possible if such cancellation occurs. All fees paid to the City of Savage shall be refunded to the Renter if this Agreement is canceled pursuant to this paragraph.
